To become a SEIS Patriot & enjoy a trip to the Washington D.C. area, the student must complete requirements (in any order) by <u>March 1<sup>st</sup></u>. With your teacher's approval, you may go to Room 305 on designated Day 4 during Writing Intervention. (Schedule will be posted). You do not have to complete the requirements in one day, simply manage your time and spread them out from **January 21 – March 1**. Any items to be turned-in, can be placed in the Patriot Program box in the main lobby, given to a Patriot Program volunteer, or email/share with <u>seispto@sesdrams.org</u>. <u>Please keep the below requirements list in your agenda</u>.

You must complete a total of 8 requirements. The following 5 are required, and the additional 3 can be selected from the list shown back of page.

Five MANDATORY Requirements to be completed:		
1.	Recite, sing, or play the 1 <sup>st</sup> verse of the "Star Spangled Banner" in the Room 305 on designated Writing Intervention day. This may be done as a solo, with friend(s), and may be pre-recorded. (words available on website, or print copy available upon request) Note: the student may choose to perform during the morning announcements instead of just for the volunteer. Please contact Ms. Trish in the office to schedule.	
2.	Complete & pass a 10 question flag etiquette quiz on designated Writing Intervention day in Room 305 (Practice questions available on SEIS website or print copy available upon request). Note: you can also practice on Quizlet, go to <a href="https://www.quizlet.com">www.quizlet.com</a> and search for SEIS Patriot Program Flag.	
3.	Write and submit a one paragraph essay (minimum of 5 sentences) about "The Pentagon" in Virginia.	
4.	Submit what patriotism means to you in a format of your choice: Poster, Video, PowerPoint, Essay, etc. (Note: Be neat and accurate with spelling & grammar as it may be displayed at the recognition assembly. If writing an essay, it should be at least 1 paragraph with minimum of 5 sentences.)	
5.	Complete community service form and submit (form available on SEIS website or print copy available upon request). Photo of you performing the service would be great! (Examples: collecting canned goods for local food bank at school, cleaning out old toys and donating to Goodwill, making cards for children in hospitals, writing a letter to a service member, etc.) This may be done on your own, or through your local community organization such as church, scouts, 4-H, etc. within the timeframe of the Patriot Program (Jan-Mar).
